

Disposal of Empty Drums and Waste Pump Flush

Empty drums have disposal options.

Drums can be sold to a recycler, or a scrap dealer. Empty drums should be drip dry. If the bungs are kept off, any residue inside will cure from moisture in the air. The top and bottom can be cut off and they can be crushed and disposed of as normal trash.

*Waste drums should not be converted to barbeque pits.

Pump Flush must be disposed of properly.

Large quantities should be disposed of through a licensed waste disposal contractor. Small quantities of Pump Flush can be mixed with polyurethane resin at a one to one ratio, by volume, and about 2 -5 % water to react to a solid waste. This should only be done outside in small quantities to avoid high exothermic heat. Once cured, the solid waste can be disposed of as regular trash.
